

KWL Expansion team form

Roster Regulations

Each team participating in the KWL league must consist of a minimum of 4 players on the roster and a maximum of 6 players. 3 Players are required to play a KWL official game. Free agents may be available to fill some Roster spots if needed.

Team Name

All team names are subject to approval by the KWL officials. All team names must be fit for a PG rating. If you can not come up with a team name, you can request a list of names from the KWL league.

Team Logo

If your team wishes to submit its own logo, it must be submitted to the league commissioner in a large pixel format and must be approved by the KWL officials. If you can not submit a logo, one can be provided to you at no cost.

Team Fee's

Teams are required to pay league fees of \$210 per team. These fees go towards providing, equipment, fields and website costs. Fees must be paid by the 1st of March. If fees are not paid, the team slot will be forfeited to another expansion team.

Season

The 2010 KWL regular season starts April 19th. Exhibition pre-season games will take place in early April. Additional spring training will be available in an indoor facility at additional cost. This will start in the middle of March. The regular season consists of 15 weeks/28 games (Middle of April-the middle of July). On June 12th there will be a KWL All-star Saturday, which will have an off night for each side of the league (All-star Break).

Spring Training

All Expansion teams must participate in the two outdoor weeks (first two weeks of April) of spring training. This will be where you learn how the game is played and how we operate. It is very important that you make sure your team is present.

Game Days

All scheduled game days will consist of a double header. Each team will have an opportunity to be the home team. Games that need to be rescheduled have to be made up before the end of the season. Please see rules for team tardiness the day of games. Games start at 6:30pm (EST). If you want to warm up before the game starts, we recommend arriving earlier.

Alternate nights

In order to work out the schedule and the amount of teams, we schedule each team 3 times (weeks) on an alternate night. Tuesday nights are the most common alternate night, however some teams have to play on opposite league nights (Monday's or Thursdays). The weeks that you are scheduled on alternate nights, you will not have a game on your normal night.

Rules

The Rules will be posted before the start of the season and it is the team's responsibility to know and understand the rules before playing. If any rules are confusing, please ask someone for an explanation. Rules are subject to change by the KWL League Committee during the season. All rule changes must have majority vote of team captains. If you have any concerns or objections to rules, please contact the KWL League Committee.

Leagues

There are two leagues in the KWL; Monday night (American) and Thursday night (National). Please request the night your team would like to play, if you can play either night, please leave that available to the KWL. Some teams can only play on certain nights. Team slots are first come, first serve.

Fields

KWL utilizes 3 fields; two located at Flesser Park off south 9th street and one located at the Township Park. The schedule will indicate which field you will be playing at.

Team apparel

Teams are requested to have at least matching color shirts that would make each team distinct. If you would like to keep Uniforms and Hat prices down, you would be encouraged to pick the team name of a Professional or Semi Professional team. Example: Tigers, White Caps, Lug Nuts, Cubs, ect.

Captain's Meeting

We will have a team captain's meeting in early April. We ask that all Captains attend. If your captain can not attend, you will need to find another player to represent your team at the meeting. Date and time TBD.
